Rectory

- > Just waiting on the buyer's side to close. It is in underwriting right now.
- > The driveway entrance will be at the buyer's expense.
- The repairs from the inspection are done and have passed the 2nd inspection. The repairs cost \$3,775.00.
- The net from the auction was \$8,286.00 and the cost of the Auctioneer will come out of this total.
- ➤ The house sold for \$125,000.00
- St. Rose capital Improvement reserve has \$5,000.00 in it plus money from the sale of the house.

Church

- Behind a cabinet in the basement there is a wall that is wet from top to bottom and has mold growing in spots.
- Archdiocese has been notified and will schedule a meeting to discuss options.

IV. Financial picture from July 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020

- ➢ Gifts are \$13,946.82 up \$9,946.82 from budget.
- Collection is \$16,671.81 up from budget.
- St. Rose property insurance was adjusted which puts us over \$5,000.00 on budget.
- Sacristy cost is down because of less people at Mass.
- > Organist is down because there is no music.
- Secretary is down on budget because of going from 3 days to 2.
- > The next finance meeting is in February.
